

## Logic of Specialization

- The specialization (Module C) starts in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester and continues during the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> semester.
- Module C courses are elective irrespective of which specialization was previously declared.
- There are Module C courses where students can collect 3 or 6 or 9 ECTS depending on the rules set by the lecturer.
- Students have to collect 18 ECTS points in total within Module C.
- Logic:
  - During the 1<sup>st</sup> year (2<sup>nd</sup> semester), each student has to collect 6 ECTS.
  - During the 2<sup>nd</sup> year (3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> semesters), each student has to collect 12 ECTS.
- Language courses **cannot be recognized** as module C courses.

## AMU additional important information

- Students have to collect 54 ECTS in the 1<sup>st</sup> year and 66 ECTS in the 2<sup>nd</sup> year.
- In case a student collects less than 54 ECTS in the 1<sup>st</sup> year and less than 66 ECTS in the 2<sup>nd</sup> year, s/he is required to apply for an exemption (section 34 of the AMU study regulations) at the AMU student office ([monika.bak@amu.edu.pl](mailto:monika.bak@amu.edu.pl)) or in the USOS-System to continue their studies with a possibility to retake the missing courses (up to 3 courses).
